




New displacements by conflict and disasters in 2020



Notre Dame Global Adaptation Initiative Country Index






International Committee of the Red Cross:

"Of the 20 countries ranked the most vulnerable and the least ready to adapt to climate change by the ND-Gain Index, 12 are in conflict."






