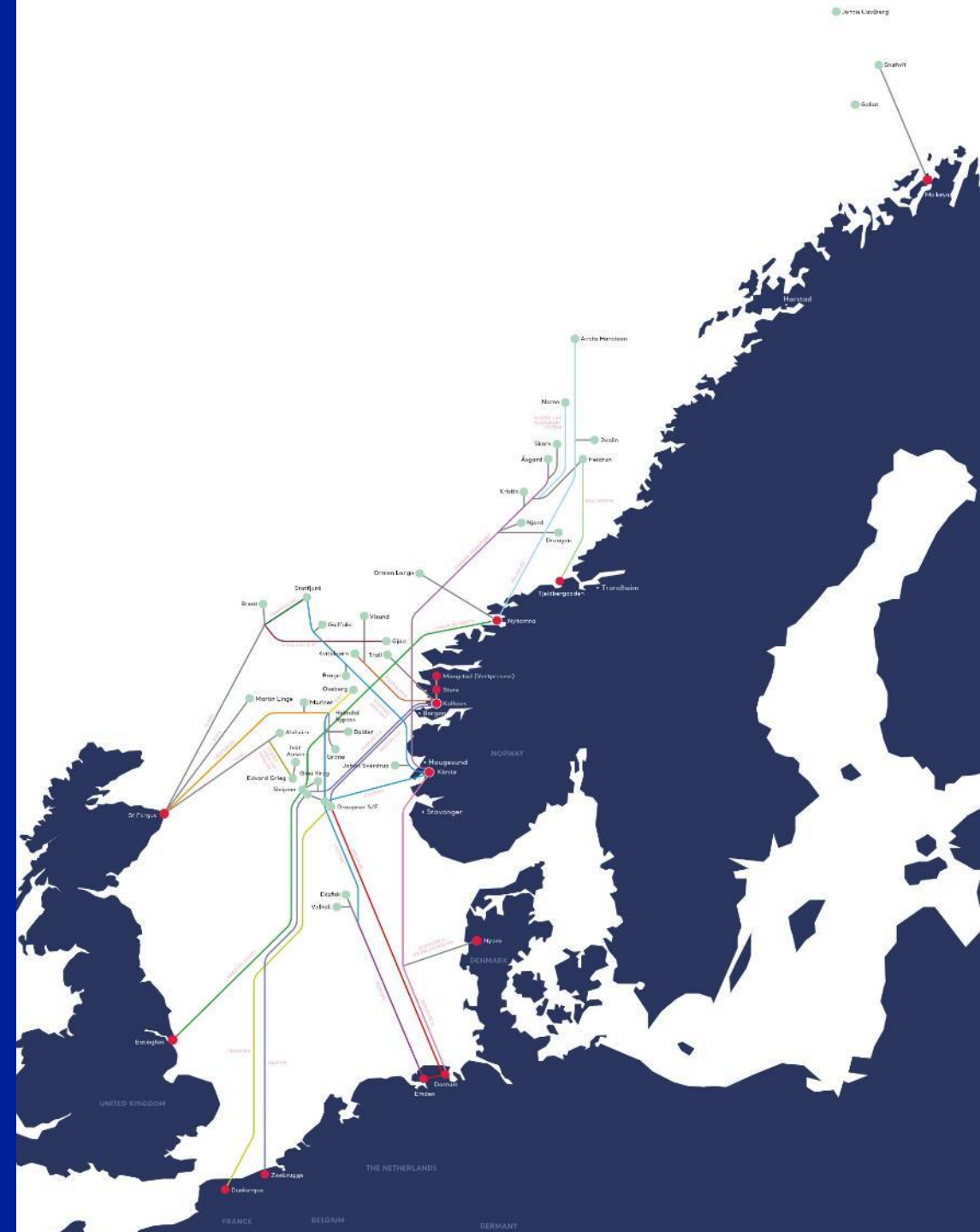


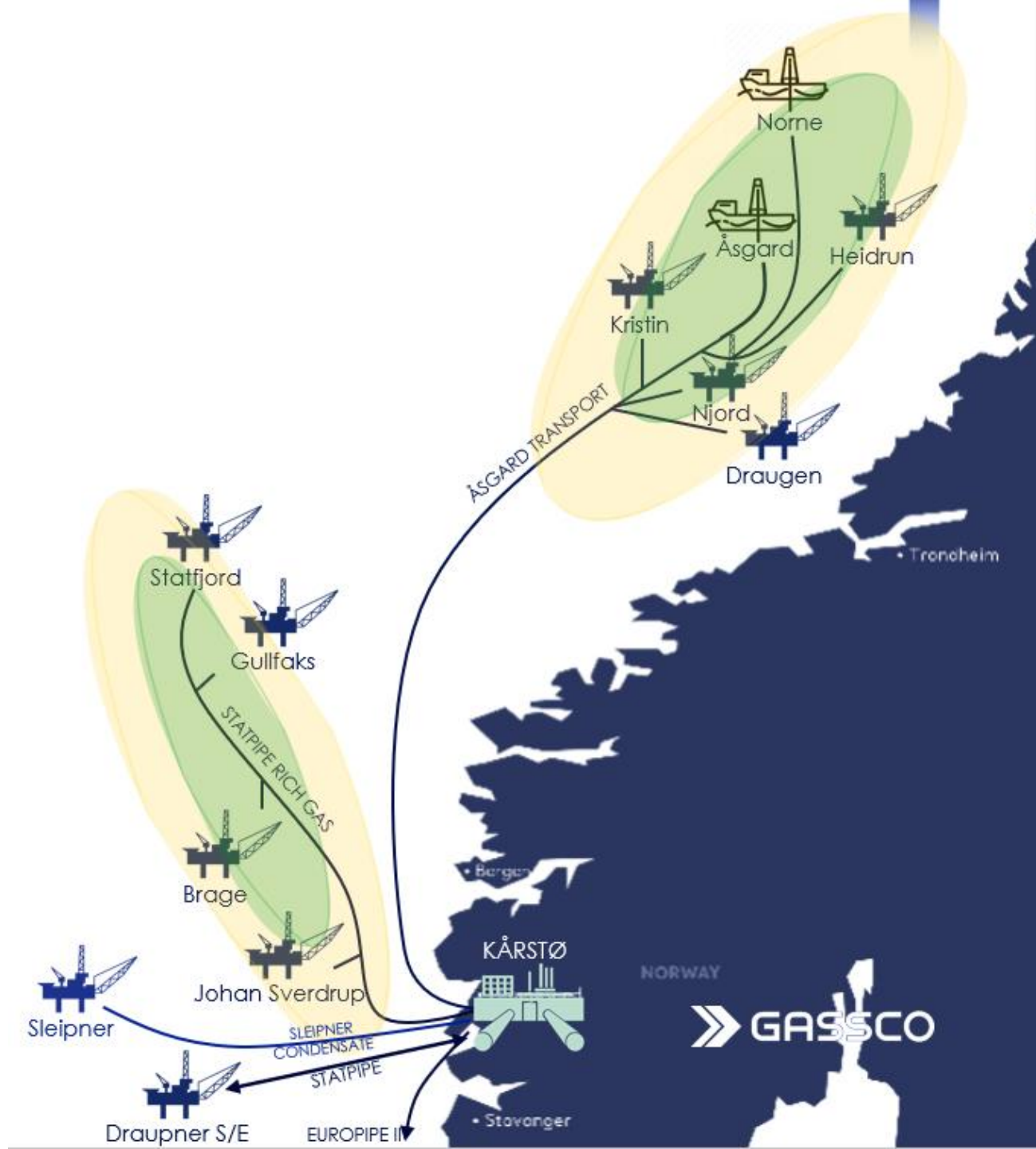
What does Gassco do?

Gassco is operator of the Norwegian gas transport system.

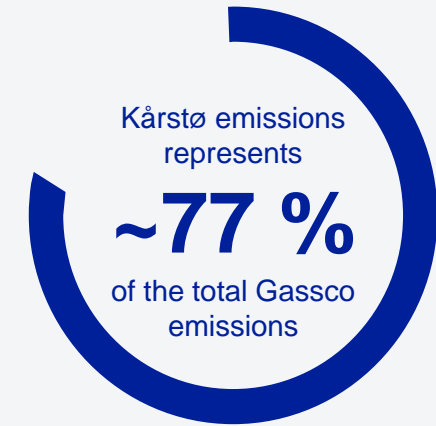
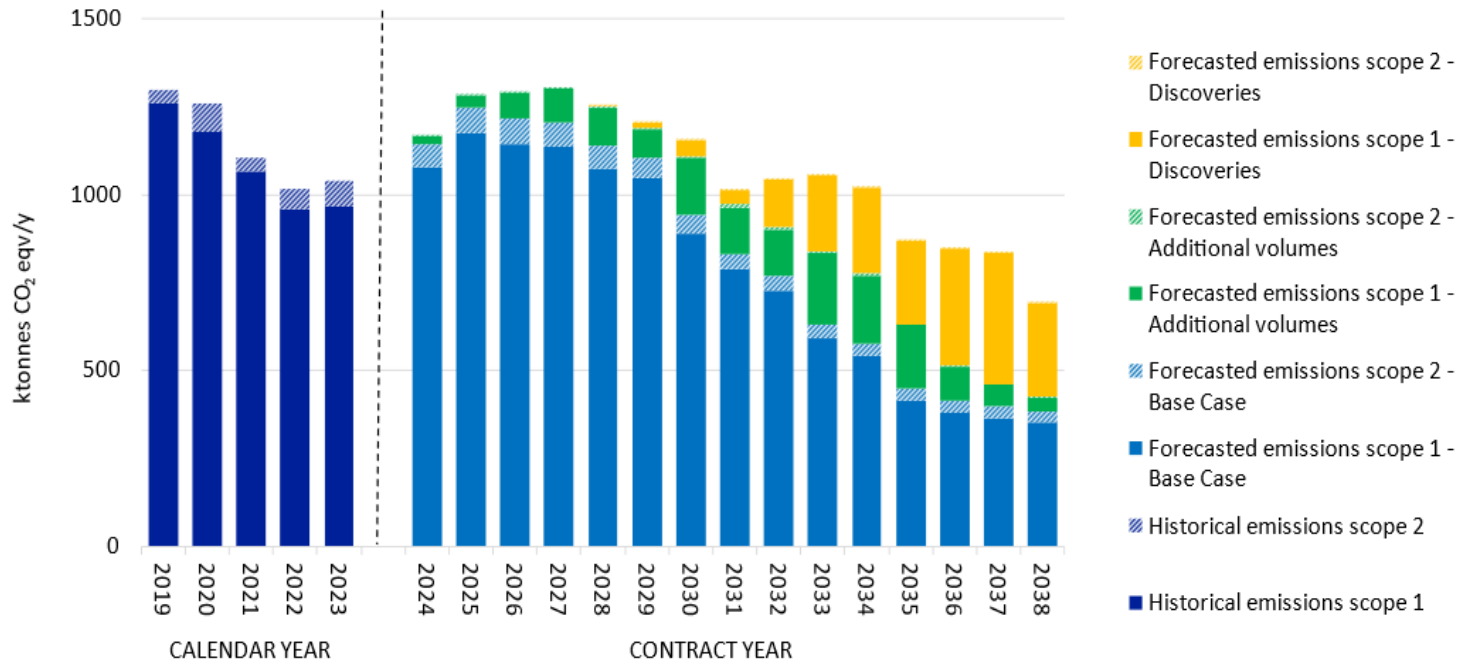


Kårstø processing plant

Pre-investment in power supply of 30 MW to secure sufficient capacity to Kårstø Reduced Emission (KREm) initiatives.

Kårstø Reduced Emission initiatives

Increased value

(increased production by increased CO2 handling and/or improved regularity, more Ethane to sales gas)

Ethane re-injection to drygas

CO2 Removal Plant Step 1

Low pressure gas stream with 95% CO2

Reduced costs

(by avoiding future integrity investments and/or reducing operational costs)

Enables removal of Ethane tank and reduced need for cooling

Enables reduced lifetime costs on boilers

Reduced lifetime costs on boilers

Potential future savings on lifetime costs

Reduced emissions

(reduced CO2 emissions by energy optimization, electrification and/or CCS)
